

ORDINANCE #66

**AN ORDINANCE TO POST A SIGN TO REGULATE ACTIVITY AT THE PUBLIC
ACCESS/SWIMMING AREA ON BASS LAKE**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNDERWOOD DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

It is in the best interest of the public health, safety and general welfare that the area on the east side of Bass Lake designated by the public access and adjoining areas used for swimming, fishing and other related activities be regulated.

SECTION 2.

Subd. 1. That a sign shall be posted near the public access area to state the following:

- a. NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY
- b. NO DIVING FROM DOCKS
- c. CHILDREN UNDER 12 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT
- d. BY ORDER OF THE CITY OF UNDERWOOD

Subd. 2. That the swimming area be designated by buoys placed no more than fifty (50) feet from the beach area.

Passed by the Underwood City Council this 1st day of August 2005.

This ordinance is effective as of August 23, 2005.
